- Stalls are available for \$15/day or \$20/weekend
- Food stand on grounds
- Entries in classes with an asterisk (\*) shall not be eligible for any three-gaited classes
- Horse/rider pairs may not enter both Ranch classes and their corresponding open or youth classes (Showmanship / Horsemanship / Pleasure)
- Horse/rider pairs may not enter both Trail and Trail In-Hand
- No show clothes, clipping, or banding required! However, jeans and boots are mandatory.
- Helmets are recommended for all youth 18 & under showing in riding classes
- Show management reserves the right to alter the showbill or schedule at any time
- Show management decisions are final
- Show management and the Ottawa County Ag. Society are not responsible for accidents, theft, loss, or injuries
