EMERGENCY INFORMATION

- For emergencies dial 911.
- An emergency phone is available in the main office or after-hours in the restrooms.
- Fire extinguishers are located in the restrooms and all buildings.
- A first aid kit is available in the restrooms.

CAMPGROUND RULES

1. To respect those who have early shows the following quiet hours will be strictly enforced.
Monday through Thursday 12am to 6am Friday and Saturday 1am to 6am.
Excessive noise or other nuisances are not permitted after hours. Keep music and talking down at all campsites
2. Posted speed limit within the grounds is 5 mph.
3. **All campers must be "hitch out" to the road.**
4. Not less than fifteen feet distance between the side of any recreational vehicle and the side of any other recreational vehicle or portable camping units located on an adjacent site regardless of the configuration.
5. There shall be ten feet distance between the ends of any recreational vehicle and any other recreational vehicle or portable camping units located on an adjacent site.
6. Sites with recreational vehicles and/or portable camping units located on the same site shall maintain a distance of at least five feet between all the units.
7. Each site shall have no more than 1 recreational vehicle or 3 tents.
8. **All Electric connections need to be grounded. NO REFRIGERATORS OR FREEZERS ARE ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF CAMPER.**
9. Camping units shall be parked and checked in as directed by Camping Director.
10. **No Campers will be permitted to check in after 9pm on Saturday or Sunday.**
11. All golf carts must be registered with the Camp Office and when the Set fee is paid you will be given a paper that must be posted on golf cart at all times. **Golf carts are only permitted in designated areas.**
12. All pets (all animals) must be registered. Pets are to be confined to your campsite, remain leashed and under control. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. **Owner will be required to remove un-registered pets from the Fairgrounds.**
13. **ALL CAMPFIRES "IF" PERMITTED SHALL BE CONFINED IN FIRE RINGS AWAY FROM CAMPERS TENTS AND BUILDINGS. THIS RULE COULD CHANGE DEPENDING ON WEATHER.**
14. All garbage will be bagged and placed in front of your camper prior to 8am; Please DO NOT set out the night before, to deter any wild animals from getting into it. **Any garbage not at the road by 8am will be your responsibility to take to the dumpster.**
15. Backflow prevention devices are on all hydrants. Do not remove or your site will be charged a \$100 replacement fee.
16. **NO FIREWORKS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.**
17. Due to health code regulations all waste water Black/Gray water must be in appropriate containers. **Do not allow waste water to drain on the ground.**
18. When using the dump station, wash down the pad and hang up the hose.
19. All sites should be free of trash and firepit debris upon checking out.
20. Check out time for campers to leave the fairgrounds is at Noon.
