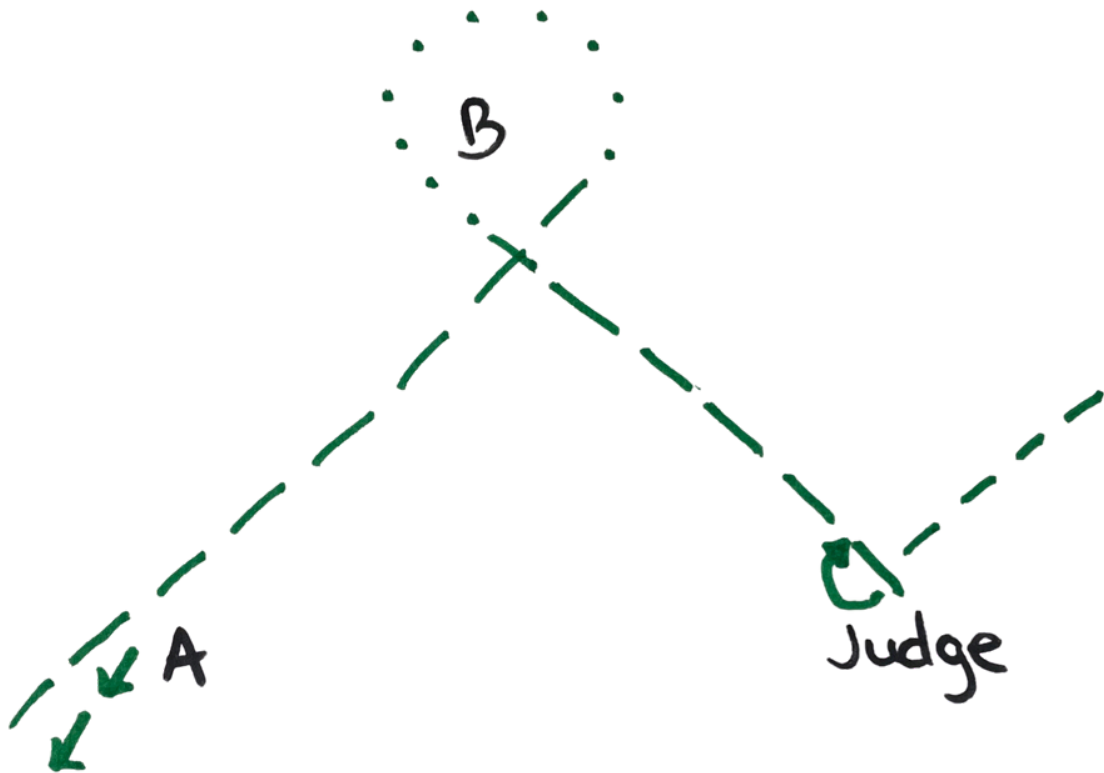


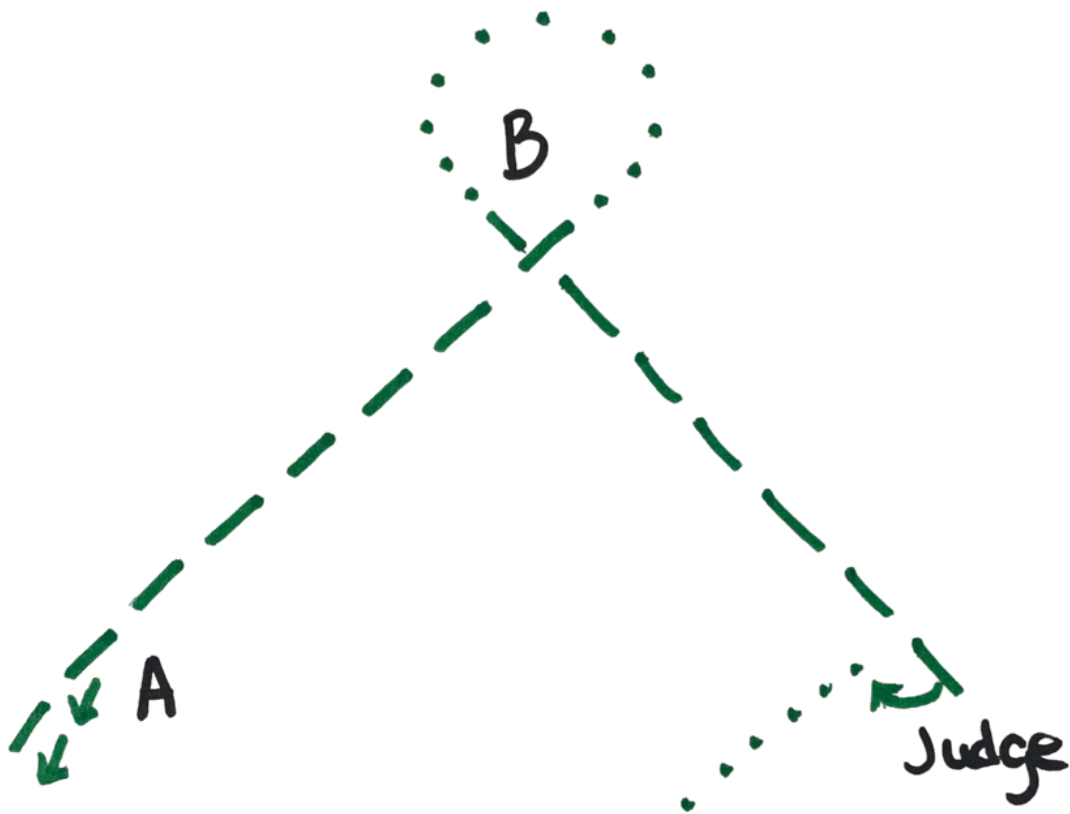
Walk Trot Canter Western Showmanship



Begin at A

1. Back one horse length
2. Trot to B
3. Walk around B
4. Trot to Judge
5. Set up for inspection
6. When dismissed, 270 pivot
7. Trot away

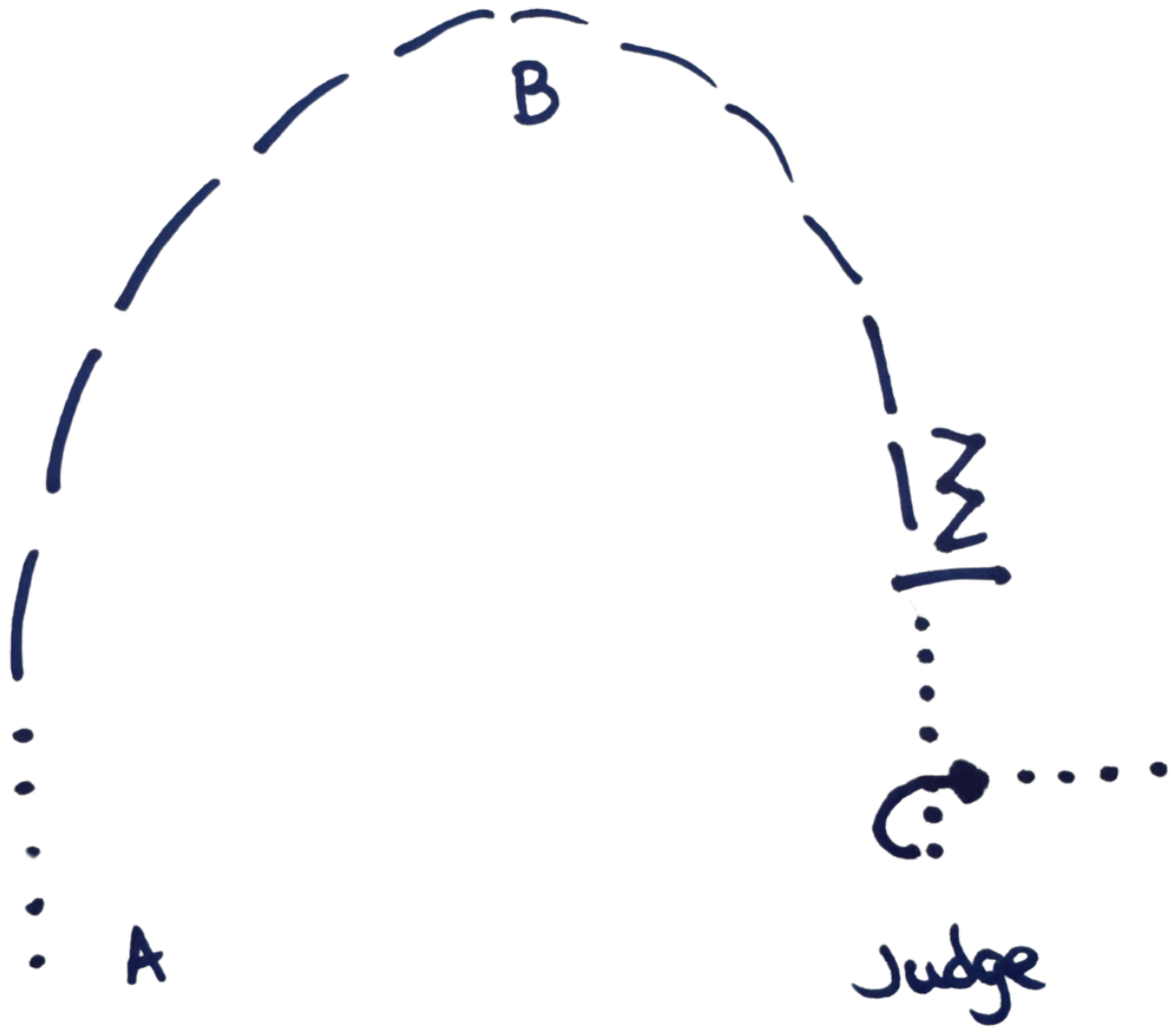

Begin at A

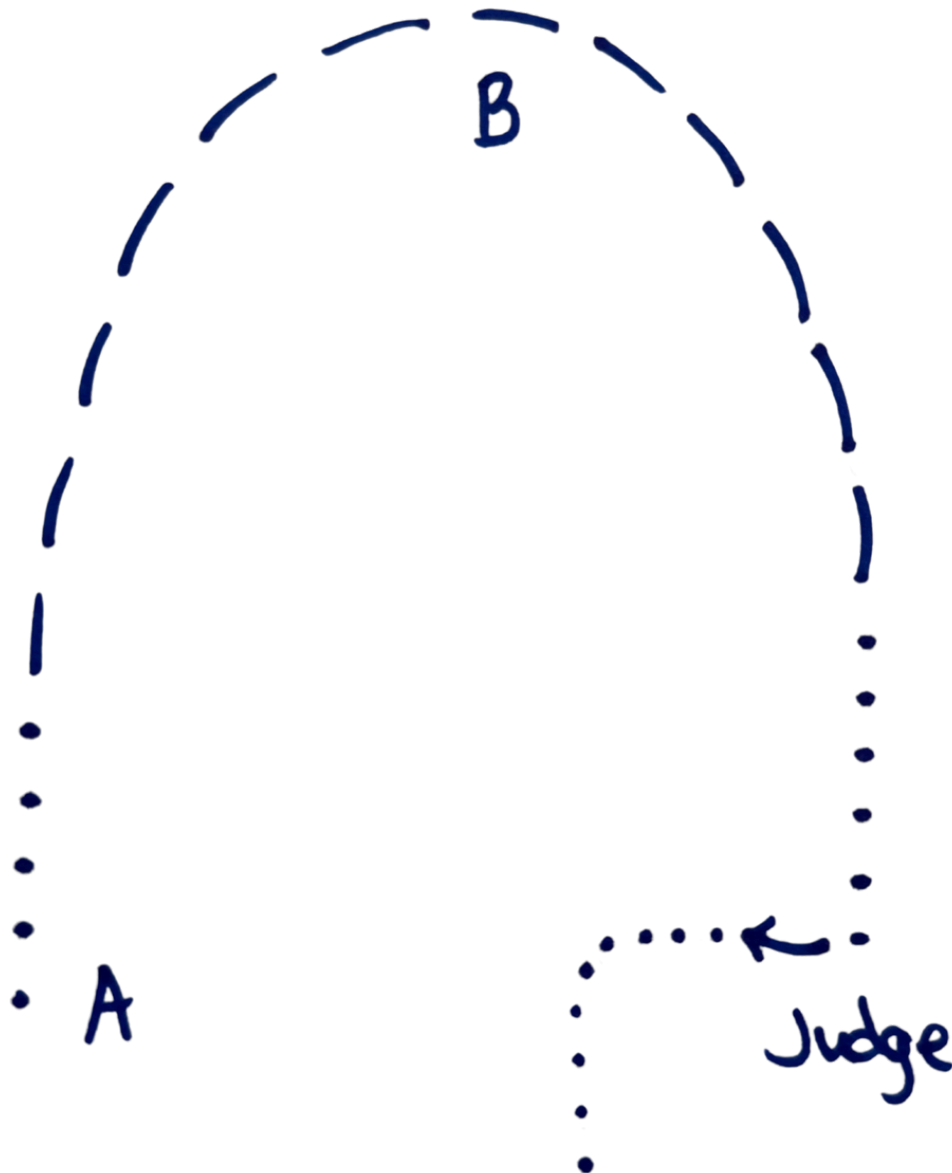
1. Back one horse length

7. Walk away

Walk Trot Canter English Showmanship



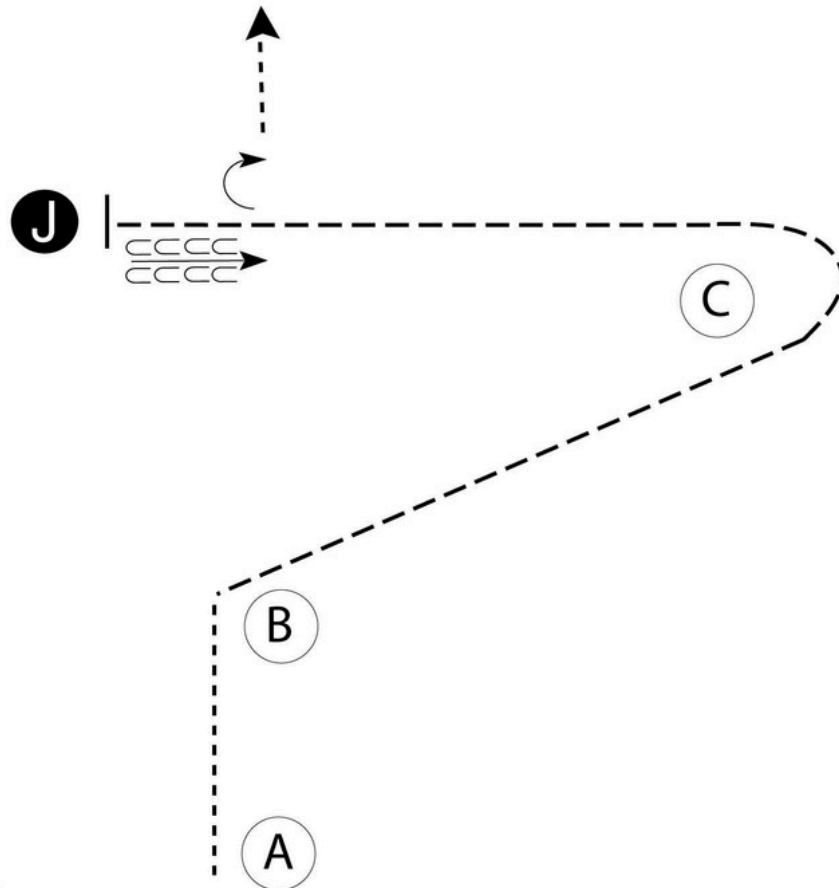
1. Be Ready at A
2. Walk one horse length
3. Trot arch around top of B
4. Halt approximately 2 horse lengths before judge
5. Back one horse length
6. Walk to judge
7. Set up for inspection
8. When dismissed, 270 pivot
9. Exit at a walk

Walk Trot English Showmanship



1. Be Ready at A
2. Walk one horse length
3. Trot arch around top of B
4. Break to walk approximately 2 horse lengths before judge
5. Walk to judge
6. Set up for inspection
7. When dismissed, 90 pivot
8. Exit at a walk as shown

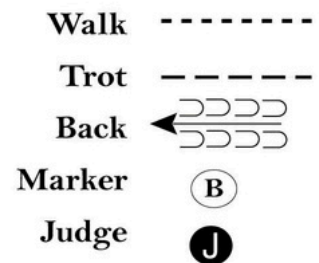
All Ranch Showmanship



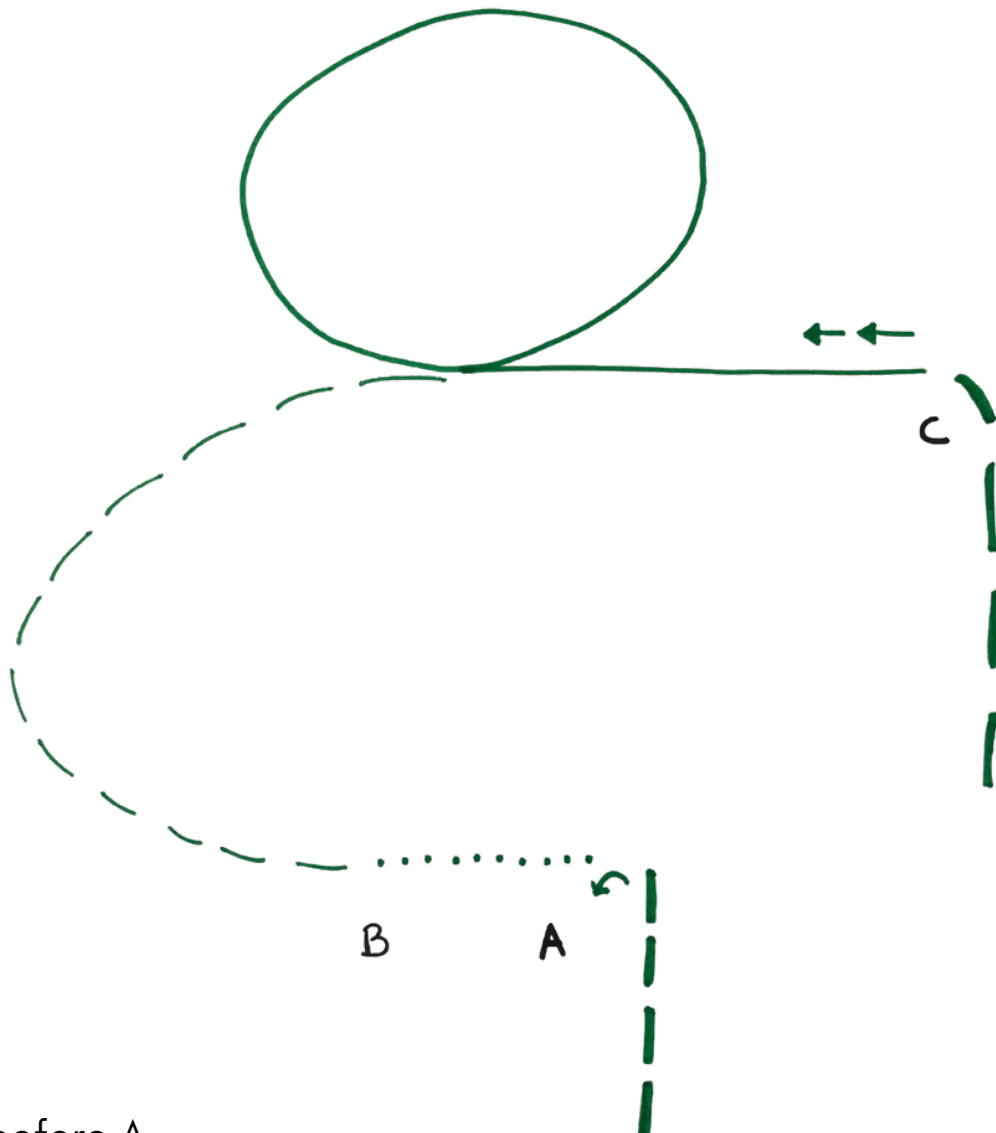
Be ready at A.

1. When acknowledged, walk to B.
2. Trot to and around C and to judge.
3. Stop and set up for inspection.
4. When dismissed, back approximately one horse length.
5. Perform a 90 degree turn and walk away from judge.

Follow the directions of your ring steward.



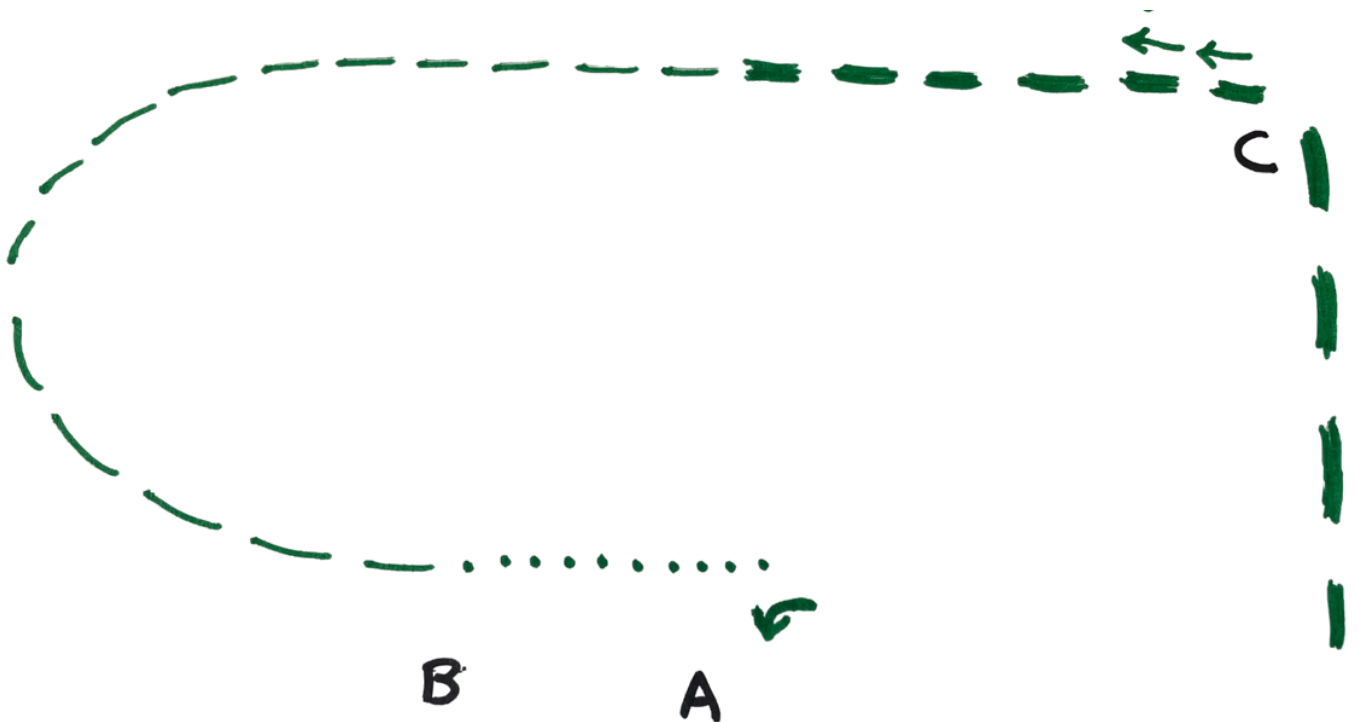
Walk Trot Canter Equitation



Begin before A

1. Sitting trot past A
2. 90 pivot on the forehand to the left
3. Walk to B
4. Left diagonal as shown
5. Canter left lead circle as shown
6. Continue cantering to C, stop
7. Back one horse length
8. Sitting trot away

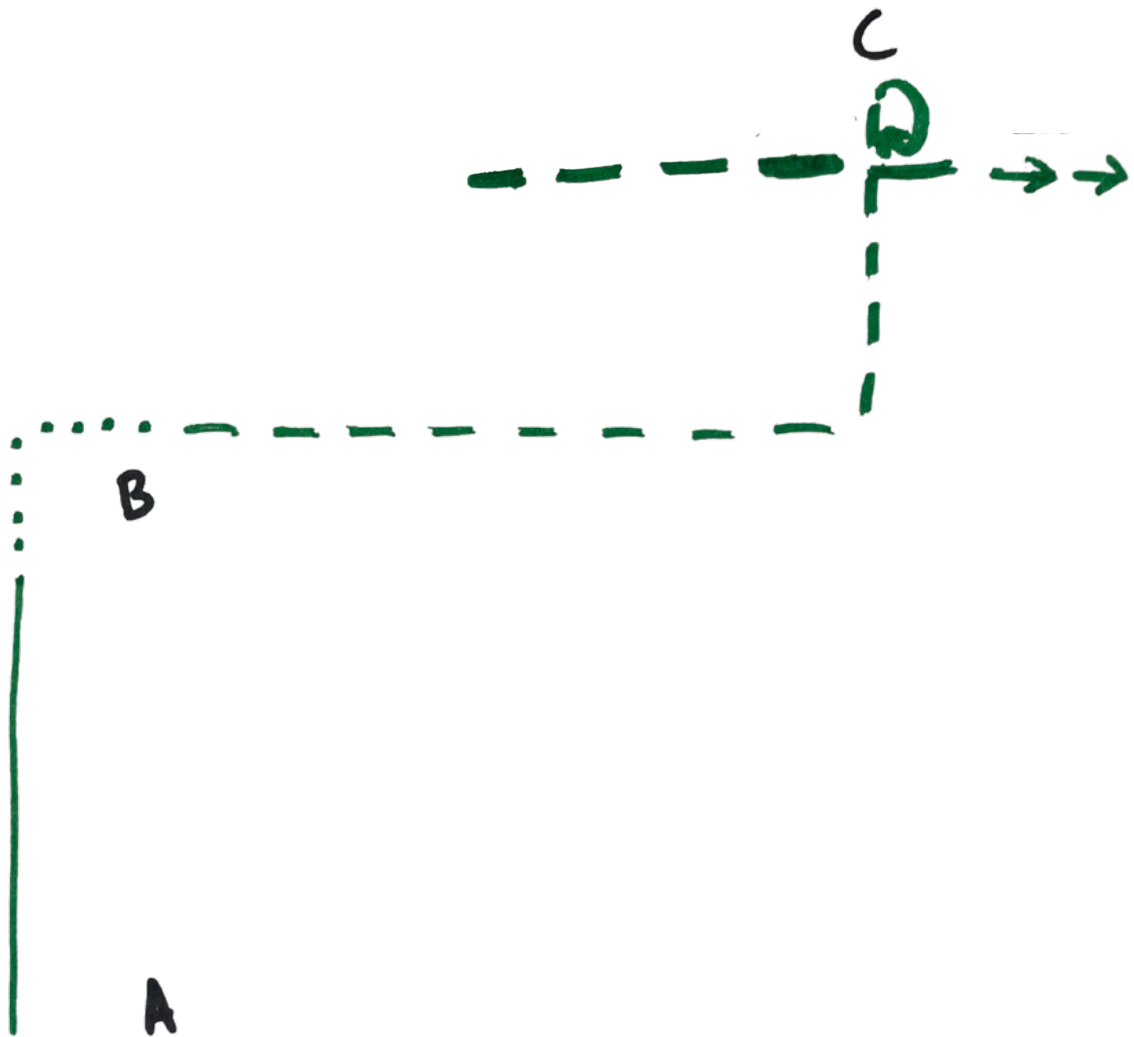
Walk Trot Equitation



Begin with horse's hip at A

1. 90 pivot on the forehand to the left
2. Walk to B
3. Left diagonal as shown until even with A
4. Sitting trot to C
5. Back one horse length
6. Sitting trot away

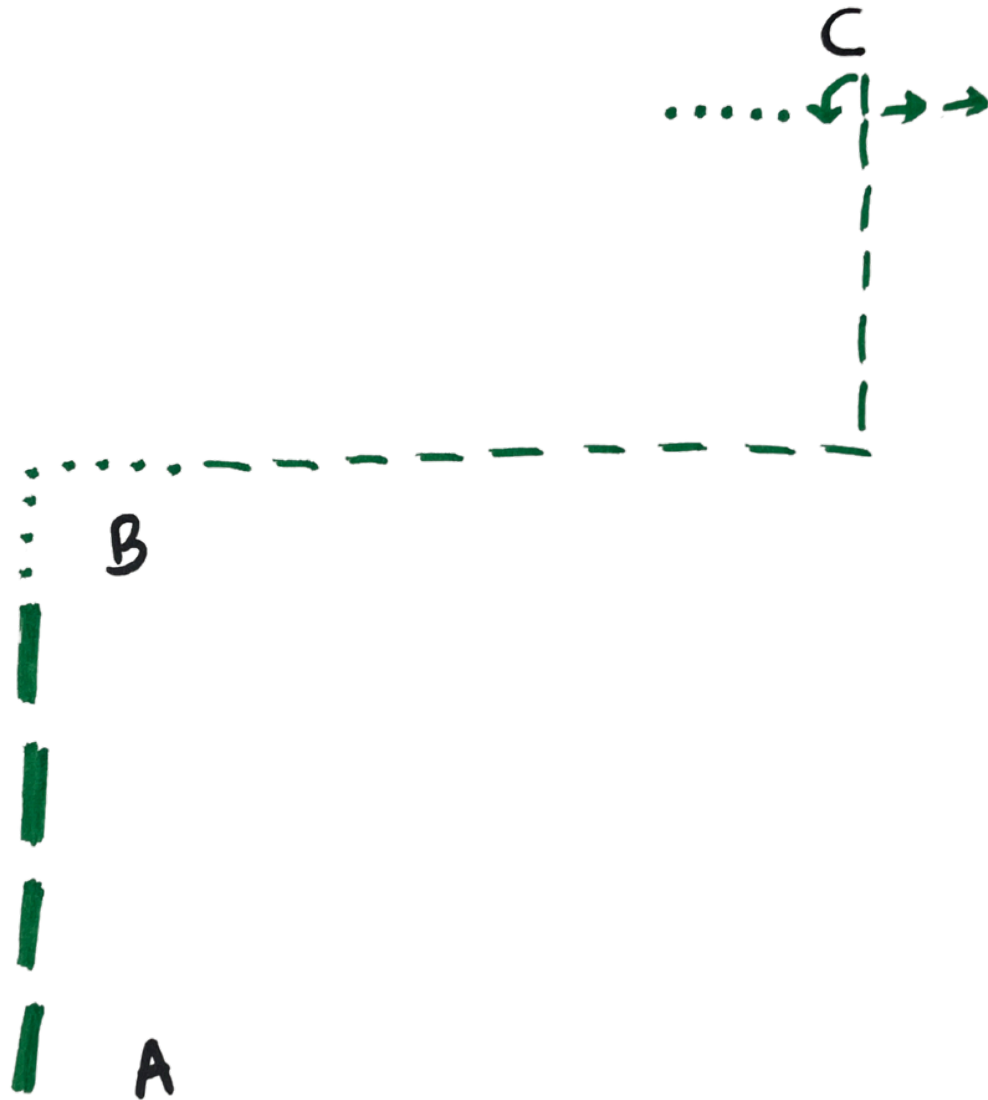
Walk Trot Canter Horsemanship



Begin at A

1. Lope right lead to B
2. Walk a square corner around B
3. Jog a square corner to C as shown
4. Stop in front of C, 270 pivot to the right
5. Back one horse length
6. Extended jog away

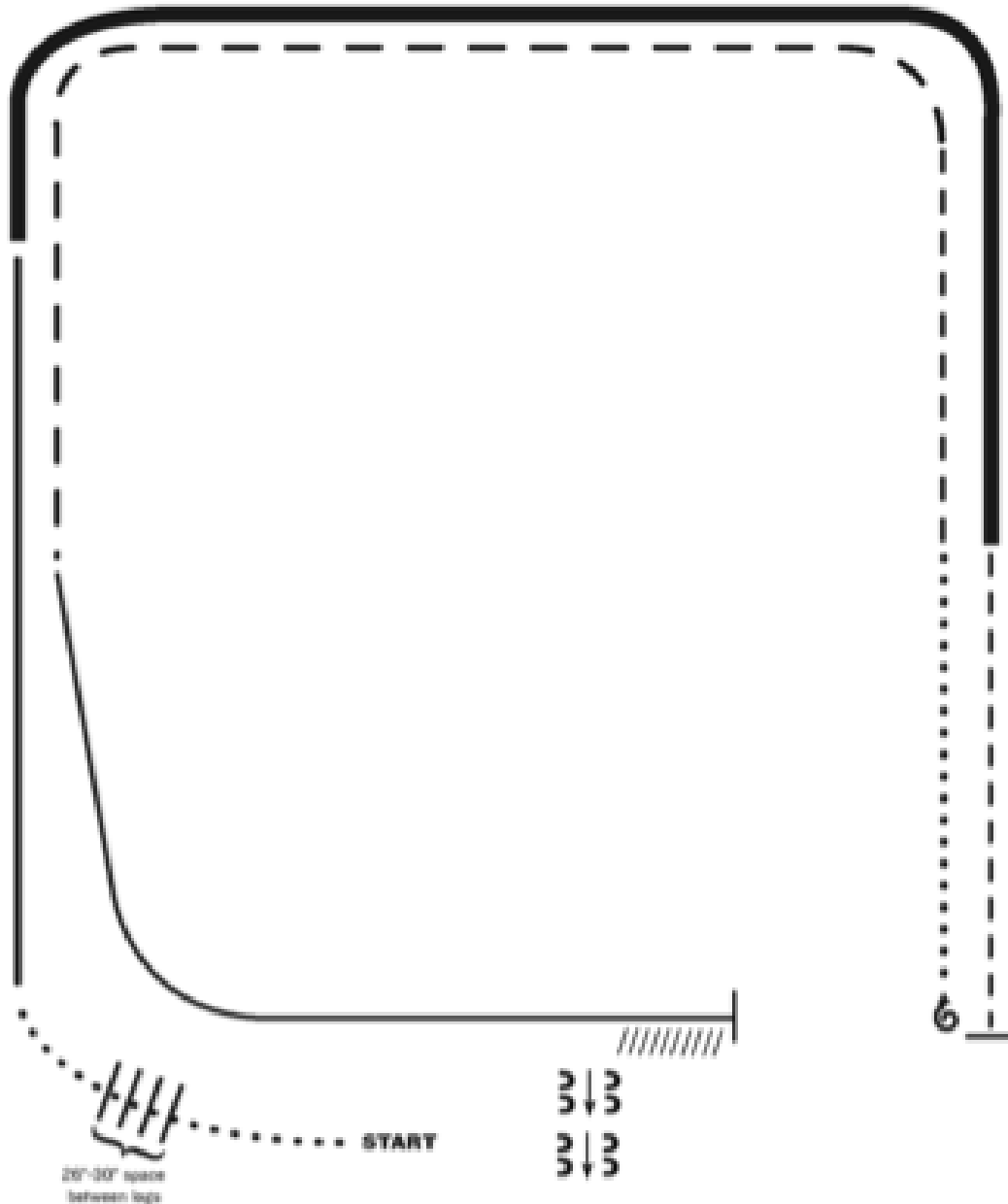
Walk Trot Horsemanship



Begin at A

1. Extended jog to B
2. Walk a square corner around B
3. Jog a square corner to C as shown
4. Stop in front of C, 90 pivot to the left
5. Back one horse length
6. Walk away

Ranch Riding



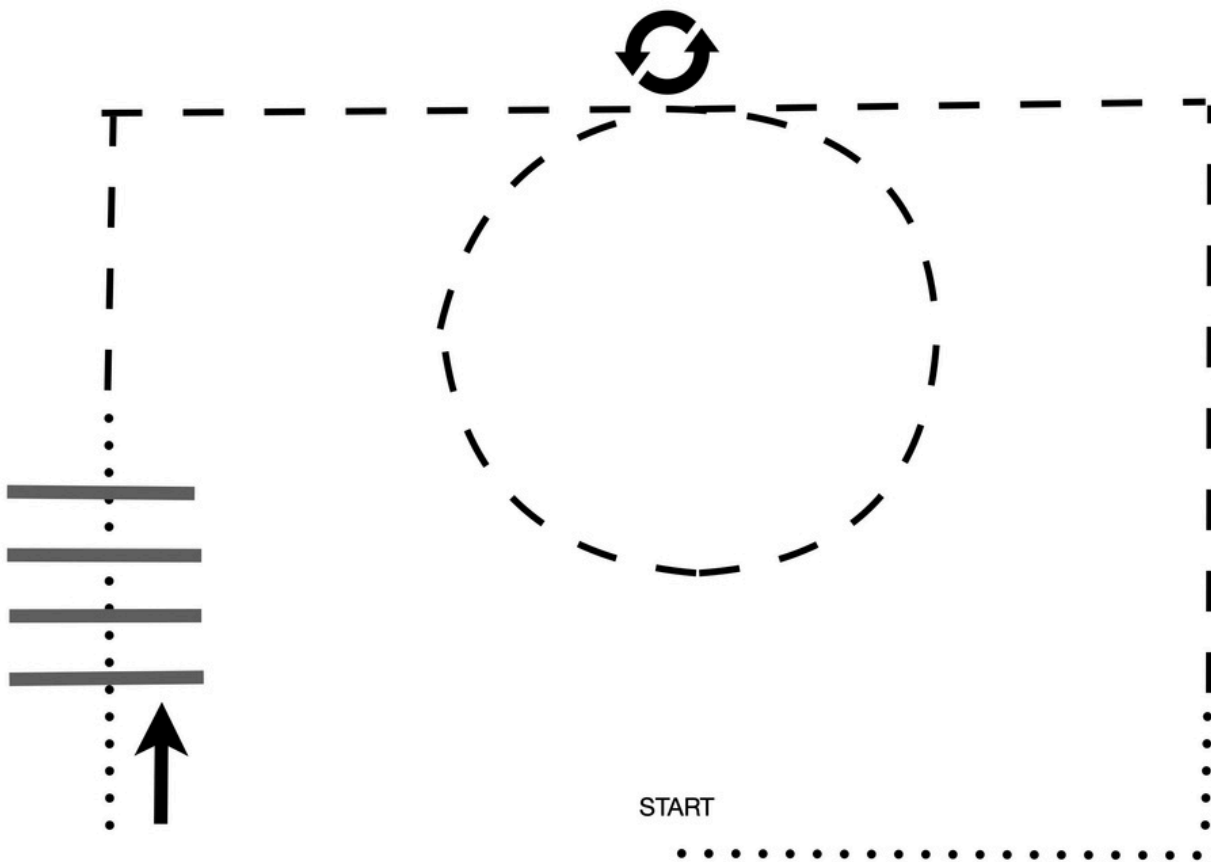
1. Walk
2. Walk over logs
3. Lope right lead
4. Extended lope (right lead)
5. Trot
6. Stop, 1 1/2 turns right
7. Walk
8. Trot
9. Extended trot
10. Lope left lead
11. Stop and Back
12. Side pass right

Note: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depiction of the pattern. Exhibitors should utilize the arena space to best exhibit their horses.

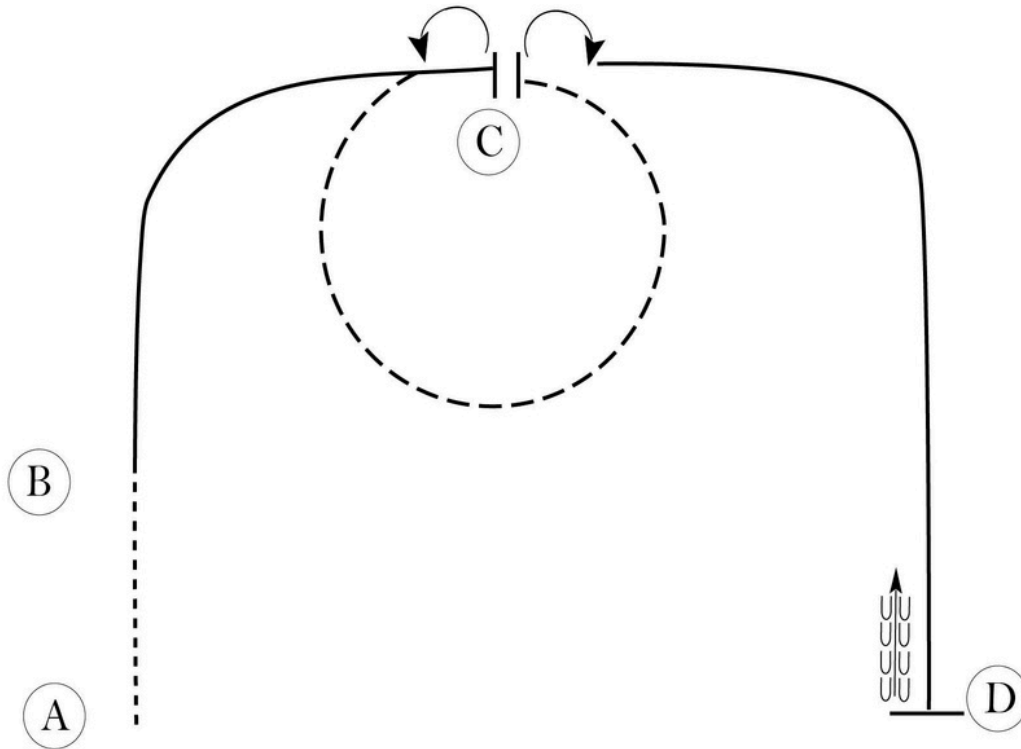
Walk Trot Ranch Riding

Class 58

1. Walk
2. Trot half way up the arena
3. Turn left, trot to center
4. Trot circle to the left
5. Stop
6. 360 degree Turn to the left
7. Trot
8. Walk over rails
9. Stop and back one horse length



Walk Trot Canter Ranch Horsemanship



Be ready at A.

1. Walk to B.
2. Lope on the right lead from B to C.
3. Stop at C and turn 180 degrees to the left on the hindquarter.
4. Jog circle to the left.
5. Stop at C and turn 180 degrees to the right on the hindquarter.
6. Lope on the right lead to D.
7. Stop at D and back approximately one horse length.

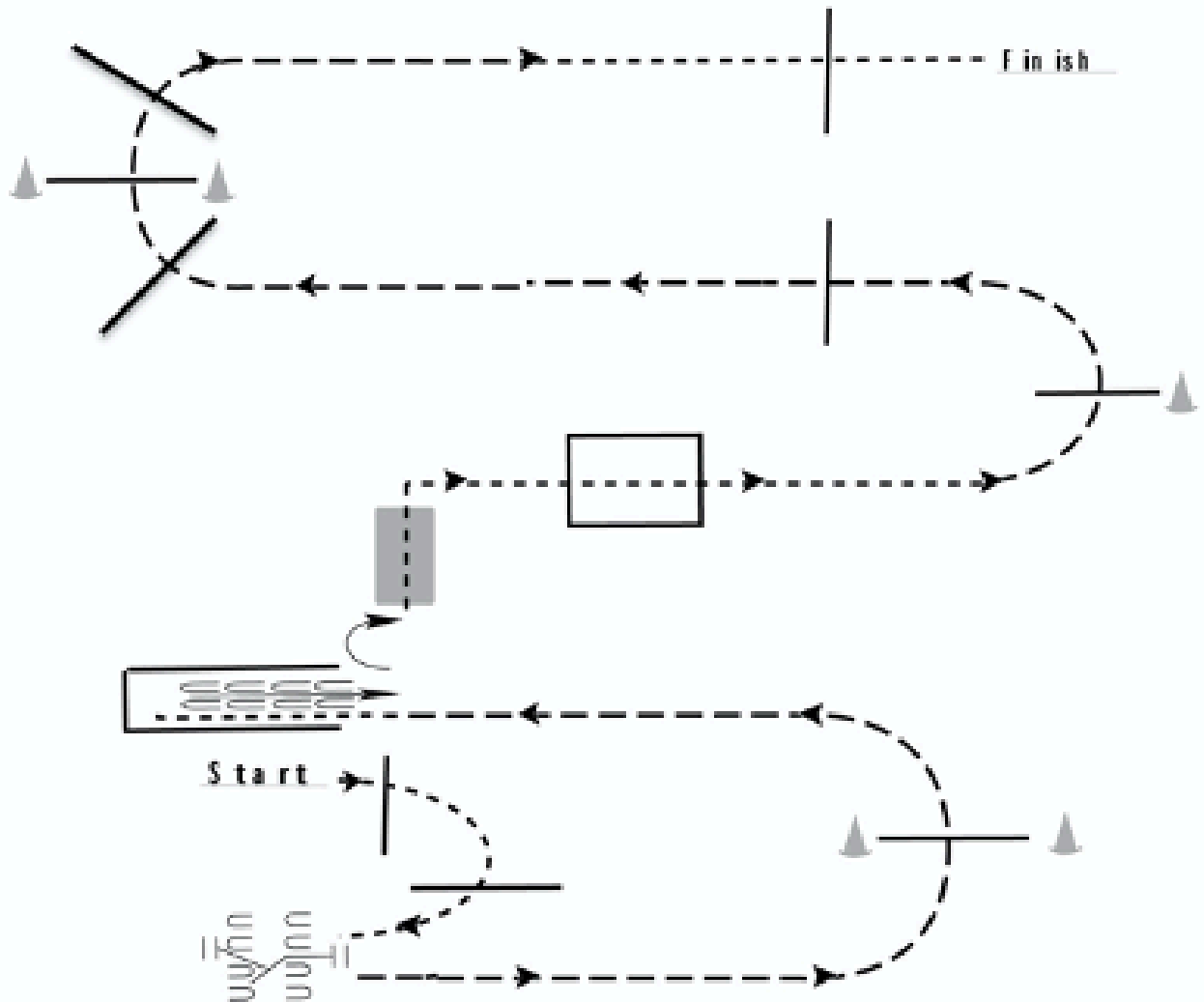

Walk Trot Ranch Horsemanship will perform extended trots in place of the lopes in this pattern.

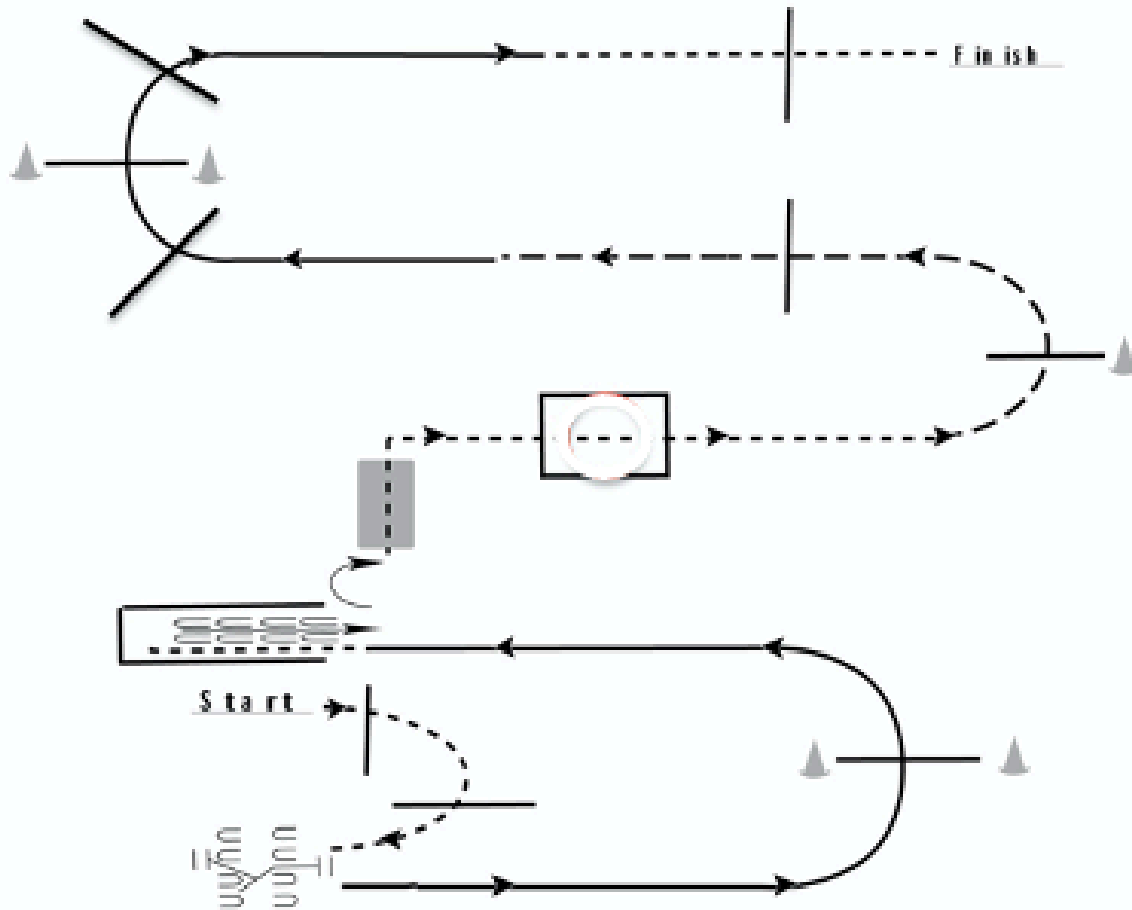
Walk Trot and In Hand Trail

Some modifications listed below.



1. Walk over two poles to gate
2. Work gate with left hand **Walk Trot will walk around gate.**
3. Trot over pole
4. Break to a walk and walk into chute
5. Back out of chute
6. Walk over bridge
7. Walk through box
8. Trot over poles
9. Break to the walk and walk over final elevated pole to finish

Walk Trot Canter Trail



1. Walk over two poles to gate
2. Work gate with left hand
3. Lope on the left lead over pole
4. Break to a walk and walk into chute
5. Back out of chute
6. Walk over bridge
7. Walk through box
8. Trot over poles
9. Lope on the right lead over pole
10. Break to the walk and walk over final elevated pole to finish
